### **GLAUCOMA**

There has been one further report of a dog who has developed Glaucoma: HELGEN CONFETTI.

The Group would like to remind you that it is now been recommended that dogs are tested every 3 years for Goniodysgenesis, and preferably before breeding.

### **CANINE GENOME PROJECT**

As part of the ongoing Canine Genome Project we have now been advised that they are focusing on Epilepsy in the Welsh Springer Spaniel. We have therefore been requested to provide the names of 3 fitting dogs, still living, who have undergone the full criteria of clinical tests including an MRI. Initially a DNA cheek swab sample will be required.
