- 1 Tolladay's Sh Ch Ferndel Comander of Bethersden ShCM Balanced head with good skull correct stop and well placed ears. Good length of neck, quality bone. Liked his height to length and holds a nice outline covering the ground with good action. Presented in very good coat and condition. BVIS.
- 2 Clarke's Jeavart Different Stroke By TigerrockJW ShCM At 10 years also a credit to owners. Masculine head of good shape, nice eye. Like the type and balance, very good neck and front. Good depth and was well presented.
- 3 Mcilwaine & Reynolds Sh Ch Glenbrows Band Of Brothers for BenoveorJW ShCM. Another masculine quality dog with good bone. Also well constructed in front good bone, coat and condition. Moved well when at the correct pace but not quite the drive from the rear as others.

- 1 Millard's Ferndel High Command At Rubylea. Quality quality youngster who was definitely making his presence felt. Lovely head and expression, good neck and straight front, good feet depth and overall balance. Most promising, in great great condition and was so together for his age. Lots to like BPIS
- 2 Knowles' Menstonia Make Mischief Another very good youngster who has lots of breed type and qualities. Good head neck and body shape. Well presented and moved freely. Just preferred length of neck of winner today.
- 3 Wren's Llon Lewys At Gwynmarren. Liked the type, size and shape of this youngster, good bone and depth. Nice head and expression also has promise and needs time, prefer a slightly better tail set

- 1 Worth's Sarabande Lord Of The Dance (AI) A lovely head and expression and won this on overall quality, well presented and was the most finished picture. Not the biggest of dogs but is balanced and has lovely type. Moved with free action.
- 2 Morgan and Schofield's Cwsscwn Who Knew(AI) Another very good youngster with lots of breed qualities. May change places with one but not as finished yet. Also in first class condition and has lovely ring presence.
- 3 Ceriati's Fascinelle Got The Charm. Like the type shape and head of the raw youngster. Good outline and very active. Needs time to fill in

- 2 Worth's Sarabande Lord Of The Dance (AI)
- 3 McIlwaine & Reynolds Glenbrows Van Goch For Benoveor JW. Liked the type shape and Balance of this dog. Good head and expression. When he got his mind on it he held a good shape on the move, well presented and has much to like.

- 1 Janes' Cwmbeili Gwilym Masculine head with good ears, good neck, well-constructed Body and another with good tail set, well developed in the rear and won this on over all Soundness. Presented in good coat and condition.
- 2 Woodham's Glynell Jiffy,. Liked the type shape and condition. Good head bone and feet. Has ample neck and moved with good outline going around.
- 3 Lockett-Roynon's Solva Captain Vere. Pleasing head and good body shape. Balanced but slightly smaller cast, was also in good condition and moved with good front action.

- 1 Rees' Hudolus Rhys Henllys At Typica. Like the head shape and ears were well set of good size, good neck front and depth of body. Strong loin and well set tail. Quality bone and another with very good body condition, moved with steady gait and holds nice shape.
- 2 Buckwell's Killena Tumbaa. Liked this one for type shape and over all balance. Good head and eye, long neck and firm outline. Not quite the ring presence of the winner and just needs a little more finish and will do very well.
- 3 Riley's Ferndel Buttermint at Ravenscroft. Pleasing head, good neck and body shape and liked the depth and length. Good bone feet and condition.

LD(14.1)

- 1 Riley's Ferndel Peanut Butter At Ravensworth JW. Masculine with good depth and quality bone, not overdone. Good skull correct stop and nice eye. Good neck and well- built body. Has strong loin and is well muscled. Nothing excessive about this boy but has balance, breed type and overall quality, which he holds nicely on the move, to win him this nice class and the CC. Presented in first class coat and condition.
- 2 Clarke's Ferndel High Fidelity With Tigerrock ShCM. Another very good quality dog that was close to the winner and you also had to consider for top honours. Very nice head breed type and overall shape. Also balanced and in good condition.
- 3 Brown's Bowdonia Ozzie. Masculine with good shape and nice eye, good neck front and balanced body. Presented in good condition.

OD(9.2)

1. Phillipson's Sh Ch Menstonia Marksman Loved this one for type shape and overall balance. A quality dog that at 6 years is still in his prime. Pleased me tremendously as held a quality picture on the move, with good reach and rear action, one you must give serious consideration to. Covered the ground positively with nice outline to win this quality class.
2. Harrison's Sh Ch Glenbrows Picture Me Now JW. Another quality dog who was close to the winner and also in first class condition. Another very good head and eye. Balanced and moved with drive, just preferred front reach of the winner today.

3. McIlwaine & Reynold's Kamunting Cast Away To Benoveor JW. Masculine balanced and making a very good trio of dog. Lovely shape and condition. Moved well but not driving off as well as the others today.

Champion D(4.2)

- 1 Graham's Sh Ch Taimere's Twister Round Nyliram JW ShCM. Masculine head, good neck and I liked his size shape and type, good bone and holds a nice outline going round. Presented in good coat and condition.
- 2 Phillipson's Sh Ch Menstonia Marksman My opinion on his overall quality stays the same but in this class he did not cover the ground as coordinated as previously done.

Spec Beg D(4.1)

- 1 Tayler's Julita Rhyne. Liked the masculine head and has good body shape. Nice bone and in good condition. Moved with steady free action to hold a balanced outline.
- 2 Gough's Julita Rukester. Of similar type and also had good head and expression. Liked the type shape and bone. Though in good condition not as finished as the winner
- 3 Bennet's Helgen Romeo The Lover. Masculine Head good ears ample neck and has good body, liked the bone feet and depth, moved free but prefer a better tail carriage.

Spec Wkg D(2)

- 1 Groot's NI/Cie Ch Isfryn On The Spot. Masculine head with good eye and well placed ears, good neck, well boned and good depth, strong loin and well angled rear. Good outline and was presented in very good condition.
- 2 Barkley's Cherryheath's Mr Mojito. Liked the head shape and ears. Good neck, very good body shape and feet, presented in good coat and holds a good topline going round.

Spec Shooting D.

- 1 Dimond and Boumonte's Islanza Going Dutch Of Roxdale. Liked the type, size, and shape of this dog. Good bone and very good condition. Outgoing and definitely has ring presence.
- 2 Thomas' Glenbrows Fire Starter. Lots to like about this one to. Type, shape and size and had good depth, just needs to show himself off a bit more to see the best.
